April 3 (Lent 4): Service at St. John--Seminarian Flo (from Trinity, New Haven): Exodus 3

April 10 (Lent 5): Service at Pilgrim--Pastor Landgraf: Exodus 32

**We are used to asking Pastor to bless our food**... But there are other things that can also be blessed. Have you ever thought of blessing your entire house? It is appropriate for homes of Christians to be blessed by the Word of God and prayer (1 Timothy 4:5). This may happen when you move into a new home, when you renovate your old one, or when something significant that happens there (such as a fire, etc.). Homes may even be blessed annually, and traditionally this is done during the season of Epiphany because of the connection to the Magi's visit of the home of the baby Jesus (Matthew 2:11).
