Are you interested in confirmation? Are you interested in receiving the Lord's Supper? At St. John, a class will be starting (in the schoolhouse) on May 15 at 1 pm, and you are invited to join us. After that class is finished, and if there is enough interest, we will be starting one here at Pilgrim. Please mention your interest to Pastor, as well as your availability and your schedule for the summer. And a good start to attending will be memorizing the Ten Commandments in their proper order.

Holy Communion will be celebrated this morning using individual cups and common cup. Visitors desiring to commune at our altar for the first time are requested to consult with the pastor. This congregation is a member of the Lutheran Church– Missouri Synod, and that church body believes that the Lord's Supper is a precious gift of God in which Jesus Christ gives us His true body and blood in a miraculous way, together with bread and wine, for the forgiveness of sins and the strengthening of our faith. Because the Bible teaches that this Sacrament may also be spiritually harmful if misused and that participation in the Lord's Supper is an act of confessing the faith, congregations of the LCMS ordinarily commune only those who have been instructed in the teachings of our church and have confessed their faith in those teachings. If you have any questions, please ask the pastor.
